I'm completely enthralled by Drew Lindsay's series and I hope he never stops writing. I'm on his 11th right now and am convinced he's one of the best detective mystery writers around. Why hasn't he won an Edgar or Shamus Award--or are those only for American writers? I hope he's at least won the Australian equivalent! He does violence well, of course, but it's the romantic relationships his detective makes that keep the reader interested. If Dashiell Hammett were alive today, he would be proud since the wordplay between him and his girlfriends would match or surpass anything between Nick and Nora Charles. Much better than James Bond!

I have enjoyed every one of Drew Lindsay's books, and have found each successive one to be just as good as the last. This particular book was engrossing, well researched, and very well written. If the bar of success is held by the reader to be that they find they just cannot put a book down, then this book certainly fills that criteria in my own opinion. Unlike another reader (male) who wrote a review of the book on this website, and found the book wanting, I found *The Dark Affair* ticks all of the boxes for a well rounded novel, certainly not just a novella. The same reader also criticized Mr Lindsay's spelling....I did notice that this same reviewer also misspelt a word, and also made a grammatical error in his review. To fans who have enjoyed Drew Lindsay's previous books, I feel you will enjoy this book just as much. In my estimation another great read, and I can't wait to read the next book by this author.

Relatively speaking Ben's body count for this story is rather low. That does not make it any less interesting as he continues to draw interest from ladies of all ilk. Mostly this takes place on an island. It is a registered site for a private club. Things go a little wrong, or Ben Hood would never be involved. And when Ben gets involved, things heat up all over. I think this is number 4 if you are reading the series in order. You don't have to but it helps keep things in perspective.

Drew Lindsay's novels are an easy read, full of adventure and appear to closely follow the writing style of recently deceased Robert G Barrett with a similar styled character Les Norton, a club bouncer from Bondi NSW Australia. Mr Ben Hood, Drew Lindsay's star character was/is certainly more refined than Les, but both were on the spot to assist those in dire straits. Fast moving, action packed novels.

Great characters and story line--very enjoyable. After I read the first book, I bought all of his others and read them one after another!

Another basic Hood novel with good looking woman throwing themselves at him. Very predictable fights and results. Some interesting Aussie tidbits.

Book number 6 was awesome and action packed. On to book number 7 now I couldn't recommend a better series to read. I've enjoyed every book so far.
