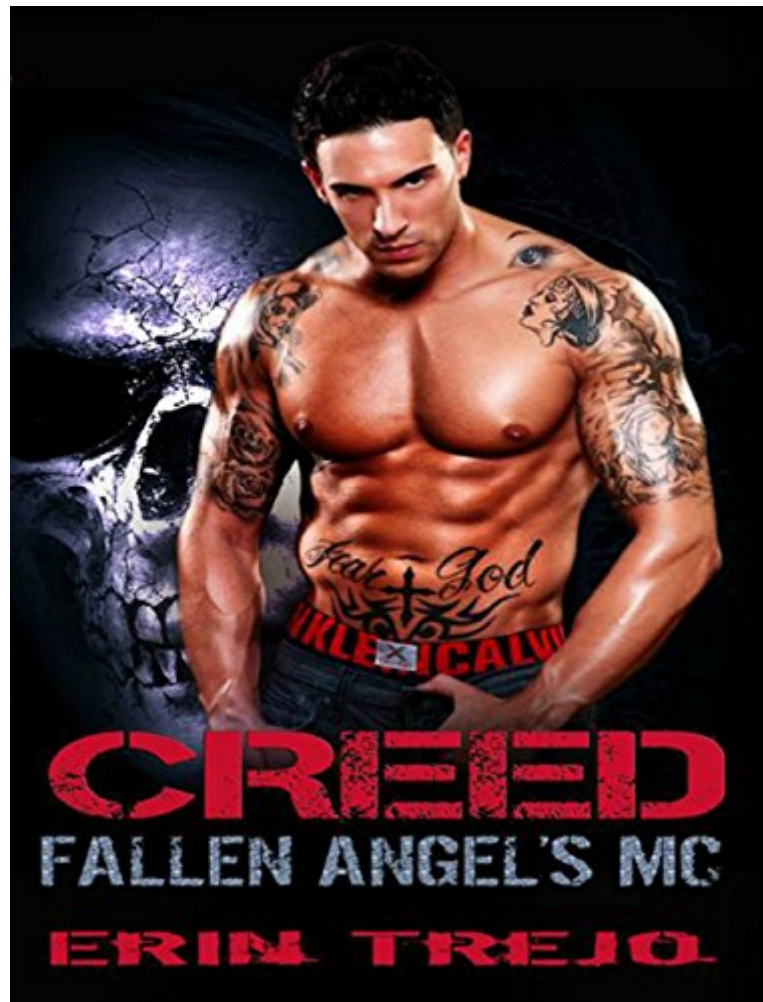

Both of these characters Creed and Jada are both broken and have demons sitting on their shoulders. They both dealt with a major loss to them in their own way, but they both haven't gotten over that loss. I mean do we ever really get over a loss? Creed has left his hometown and is now a member of the Fallen Angel's MC. It never becomes really obvious how he became a member. But after his best friend Jason dies, he seems to have lost his way a bit. He basically now seems to do all the dirty work for the Fallen Angel's and he seems to have an issue taking someone's life for the club. That is until he runs into Jada again and you get to see a different side of him. You could always tell the attraction between the two, and now five years later it's not any different. Jada was such a sweetheart. You can tell the loss of Jada's twin brother hasn't been easy on her either. When we get to see her again, it's been five years since her brother's death. It's obvious some stuff has happened to her and we find her with The Shadows MC. Which doesn't seem to be a much better place for her to be.

I was given Creed as an ARC in exchange for an honest review. Even though I read this series slightly out of sequence, I thoroughly enjoyed each and every one of the Fallen Angels MC series by Erin Trejo. This was Creed and Jada's story, and it was a very compelling one. Jason (Jada's brother), Creed, and Jada all grew up together. She always had a crush on Creed, and he really wanted to show her what crushes were all about, but Jason told Creed that Jada was hands off for him, and Creed kept his distance until the night Jason died in a senseless auto accident. Both Creed and Jada were devastated by Jason's death, and came together for comfort and solace, but it turned into a sex on the roof comfort too. Sadly, Creed felt what he did with Jada was wrong, and disappeared. Jada tried to cope with living with an indifferent mother and all her abusive boyfriends. One of the boyfriends raped her, and Jada just left as her mother didn't or wouldn't believe Jada. Jada now on the streets and in a downward spiral was picked up by Kenny Rolands and his MC, and while he was all nice and sweet to her in the beginning, it was long before Kenny turned her out in the streets to earn money for the club.
