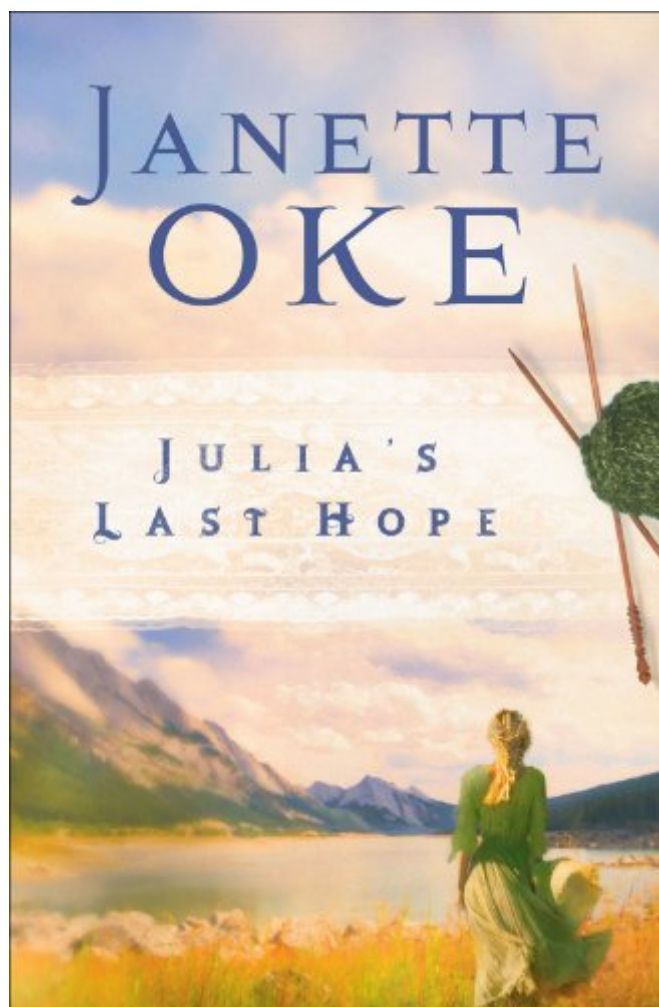

The mill shuts down and the town dries up. Julia stays and encourages some of the hold outs to persevere. In the end, there was no real point to the book, just failed communication between husband and wife. Not the quality of her other books which always seemed to not only have a point but got you well invested.

The many different characters she brings to life are each memorable and touching as they go in and out of the boarding house. Each one's visit is like a story within a story.
