

This richly woven novel is set in the Styx of Western Australia, nowhere near any bustling cities, but in proximity to the gigantic mining operations that have revived the economic life of the local Aboriginal tribes and a bundle of what in Australia are call FiFo workers (the fly in, stay usually on site in company towns, do a 14 day s*** (it varies of course) and then fly out) to Perth 2000 km away or even to Brisbane 4000 kms away. The story is tightly plotted, and is very vivid in its descriptions of people and places in that area of Australia a very long way from anywhere. The protagonists are vividly described, the plotting is well up to the authors already high standard, and the denouement is

marvelous. A book to be read in a sitting or two at the most, not because it is light on characters, but because some of the laconic Australian bush language may not reside in the forefront of the readers mind. most enjoyable novel for me as I have been thru the area described and it is fairly true ti its setting in time and place.
