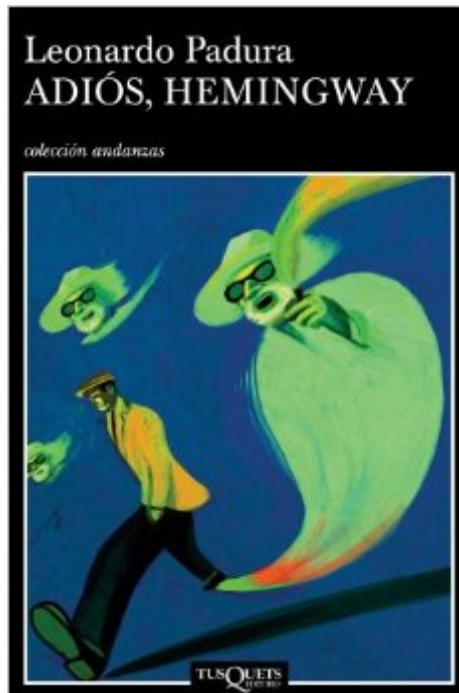

## Synopsis

This is another well-written and entertaining read from Mr. Padura. Hemingway fans, in particular, will appreciate this fascinating story imagined and constructed by Padura Fuentes that weaves in known aspects of the U.S. author's life in Cuba, including his house, boat, haunts, and associates. Even Ava Gardner has an intriguing cameo of sorts. This book is available in an English translation and I've taken advantage of this to recommend Padura to English-speaking friends. All reports have

Padura has become emblematic of Cuban contemporary Cuban writers. Without exhibiting overt political opinions in his themes, nevertheless he places characters in situations that clearly describe the authoritarian cultural reality enveloping his characters. His Mario Conde detective character is intimately portrayed and the mannerisms, thoughts and human emotions of this wasted failed aspiring writer (in the character's defeated view) gains the affection of the reader. His vocabulary in Spanish is superior, the ease of his descriptions vivid. His intense emotional ties to his mother country drip in every sentence. The translation seemed weak but it was cursorily read for the moment. The love hate relationship with Papa Hemingway becomes an internal motivation to propel the ex detective to continue searching for clues to the mystery. His descriptive eroticism is an outstanding feature of his works which Padura readers expect. Padura's most ambitious and remarkable work is "El hombre que amaba los perros"
