

Although it is June I was intrigued to read Bryan Mooney's latest confection "Christmas in Vermont: A Very White Christmas". I am so glad I did. This is a terrific story about two people, Jack and Hope,

who meet in an ugly circumstance and unknowingly form a "soul mate" bond. Jack a Marine and Hope a teacher both working in the middle east comfort and give each other strength after they are attacked and badly injured at a school. They are both unconscious when they are rescued and sent to different locations to recover. Both wonder with longing about what happened to the other. When fate brings them back together years later in Vermont during the holidays, the magic of the season serves to ignite and invigorate their feelings for one another even though they are both involved with others. While hand delivering once lost Christmas cards and letters found from the previous year, as a favor to his uncle, the retiring postmaster, Jack discovers that there are many in his hometown that are in need and hurting during the holiday season. The cards serve to bring peace to some and motivation to others. Jack and Hope find that together they can make a difference as they rally the small town of Woodstock, to revive the Veterans Hall. The love of community that this village exhibits as they all step up to make it happen is endearing and charming to read. The way that Mr. Mooney weaves their love story through these events is very engaging and makes putting the book down next to impossible. I really enjoyed this book. I was fascinated by the vivid descriptions of the Wassail Festival and how lovely the portrait that the author painted of this quaint town seemed to draw the reader in so smoothly and completely.
