

The Siren picks up the story just a few weeks after the end of book one, Warren and Sloans relationship really develops and although it may be perceived that they 'needed' to be together I didn't see it as a difunctional. The dynamic between Warren, Nathan and Sloan was well thought out and just added to the whole story. There are a lot of questions answered in this book but then just the perfect cliffhanger ready for the next... On that note, Elicia, stop what your doing and get writing!

elicia Hyder is one of my favorite authors out there. Every book is different and enthralling in their own way. When I started to read the Summoner, I literally couldn't stop reading it. And the same happened with The Siren. You won't get dissapointed. In fact, you'll get even more addicted to the whole series and you'll be expectantly waiting for the third book (we can wait together!)

Angels on earth, living with us, and solving crimes, how cool is that! Sloan has lifeâ ™s ups and downs just like the rest of us but as part angel she is able to use powers to help find persons in need. The story takes you into a world that is fun and exciting. Once I started the book had a hard time doing anything else. The hard part is now I have to wait for the next book.

I hate Elicia Hyder. She always makes me cry. Really cry. I can count on at least one moment in her books when I am reduced to tears. I LOVE Elicia Hyder. I can count on, in every single one of her books, being completely entertained and engrossed beginning to end. The Siren is no different. It picks up where The Soul Summoner left off. The same great characters make a reappearance including Sloan's parents and her friend, Adrianne. Sloan and Warren, with Nate in tow, stumble upon the nature of their supernatural origin. The bad guys in this one are of the human and celestial variety. New alliances are formed and even more enemies surface. The dynamic trio don't back down though, leading to fight scenes that are brutal and bloody yet cleverly crafted in an awed pleasure-terror way that only the best writers can accomplish. Sadly, the love triangle we thought resolved in the first book has spilled over into this one. Sloan and Warren are genuinely in love but

wedged in a relationship tainted with uncertainty. There is a refreshing chemistry and earnestness to this love triangle as the leads struggle with their dilemma while hoping against hope they come out of this impasse with their 'souls' intact.

I am prefacing my review with a promise that there are no spoilers ahead, as I do not want to ruin the book for anyone. I just finished the book and it is so good. Elicia Hyder has done it again! I laughed, cried, cheered, and enjoyed every minute of it. So much happened! The mysteries of Sloan's origins are solved with the introduction of two new (explosive) characters. Sloan and Warren learn more about who and what they are. She finds out that she and Warren are not the only ones with gifts. Sloan experiences loss, love, a (sort of) bond with a former nemesis, evolving powers, and a brand spanking new mystery to solve (with the help of Nathan, of course). The book ends with one hell of cliffhanger. I stayed up until 4:30 am so that I could finish it. I cannot wait for book 3 (withdrawal symptoms will be with me until it is released - Lol). I ended the last book being Team Nathan, but this book has moved me over to Team Warren. What can I say, he won me over in this one. I promise you that you will not be disappointed with 'The Siren', as it has everything - action, romance, humor, mystery and more!:)
